

## **MET's Bully**

### **History of this fly:**

Sherry Steele Developed this fly to fish for Bull Trout on the Metolius River - June 2015



**Thread:** White 6/0 UNI

**Hook:** Streamer hook #8, #6, (or equivalent)

**Eyes:** Dumbbell – Tied on top

**Tail:** none

**Body:** Thread & Z-Yarn – White, Olive

**Thorax:** none

**Throat:** Red Saddle Hackle

**Wing:** Bird Fur Natural Grizzly

Techniques used in this fly:

- 1) Mounting Dumbbell Eyes
- 2) Working with Zlon Synthetics
- 3) Handling Hackle fibers for throat

This fly is not weighted and is used with a floating line with sinking tip. This un-weighted fly makes it easier to cast than its weighted brothers. After casting, and let it sink then strip. Fish it just like a Wooly Bugger or swing it. This fly is for stream fishing deep pockets for Bull Trout.
