Tag: Fine oval silver tinsel and pale yellow floss

Tail: Golden pheasant crest, over which are two small strips of red goose and kingfisher, both half as long as the tail.

Butt: Scarlet Berlin wool

Body: Flat silver tinsel

Ribs: Oval silver tinsel

Hackle: Natural red game hackle (brown), followed by natural guinea fowl hackle.

Wing: Four yellow neck or saddle hackles, with a white saddle hackle on each side half as long as the yellow. Over this on each side is a fairly wide strip of yellow turkey as long as the wing, with thin strips of red turkey married to it, top and bottom. Over this is a wide strip of Barred Wood Duck to level with the butt.

Topping: Two golden pheasant crest feathers.

Shoulders: Jungle Cock of moderate length.

Cheeks: Kingfisher, over the jungle cock, and shorter.

Head: Black with a band of red in the center.
