History of this fly:

Sherry Steele Developed this Dry Fly Variant Design from a fly purchased on the web several years ago by T.R. McCrystal – Owner Jen’s Gardens Sisters, OR - Proven producer on Central Oregon Rivers during and after the Green Drake Hatch.



Hook: Dry Fly – TMC 2312 #8, #10, #12 (or equivalent)

Tail: Moose Mane

Rib: 6/0 Olive Waxed UNI Thread (or equivalent)

Body: Light Olive &/or Dark Olive – Dry Fly Fine

Wing: Mallard Flank - Natural

Hackle: Dry Fly – Olive (size 12)

Techniques used in this fly:

- 1) Hand stacking – Moose Mane
- 2) Dubbed Tapered Body
- 3) Thread Ribbing
- 4) Mallard Wing – sizing & material prep
- 5) Hackle sizing & wrapping through wing material.

Hook: Tiemco 200R #20 & #18

Thread: Olive 8/0 Uni

Body: Peacock Hurl

Wing: Deer – White Tail w/black tips

Hackle: Brown &/or Grizzly

Techniques used in this Fly:

- 1) Working with smaller dry flies & the challenge.
- 2) Peacock hurl – choosing the best & handling so it doesn't break.
- 3) Deer Hair – Picking the right hair, cleaning & prepping, stacking & mounting.
- 4) Hackle – Sizing and getting close wraps.
