

Favorite Lake Flies Tying Materials

Sheep Creek Special –

Hook = Dai Riki 730 or any 2X long sizes 6 – 20 (12 for class)

Thread = Black

Tail = Brown hackle

Body = Dark olive chenille

Wing = Mallard flank w/ 4 fibers pearlescent crystal flash

NOTES:

Runges Leech –

Hook = Dai Riki 700 or any 3X or 4X long sizes 4 – 10 (10 for class)

Thread = Brown or black

Tail = Red yarn

Body = Brown mohair

Hackle = Pheasant rump

NOTES:

Carey Special –

Hook = Dai Riki 700 or any 3X or 4X long sizes 4 – 14 (10 for class)

Thread = Black

Tail = None

Rib = Gold or silver tinsel

Body = Peacock herl

Hackle = Pheasant Rump

NOTES:

Half Back –

Hook = Dai Riki 730 or any 1X to 4X long sizes 8 20 (12 for class)

Thread = Black or olive

Tail = Pheasant center tail tips

Rib = Fine gold wire

Body = Peacock or pheasant tail

Thorax = Peacock herl

Wing case = Pheasant tail

Legs = Tips of wingcase fibers

NOTES:

Timberline Emerger –

Hook = Dai Riki 730 or any 2X long sizes 12 – 16 (12 for class)

Thread = Grey

Tail = Grey fluff from base of pheasant body

Rib = Fine gold wire

Body = Grey dubbing

Wings = Grizzley hen hackle tips

Hackle = Brown

NOTES:

Cascade Special –

Hook = Dai Riki 270 or any 3X long sizes 10 16 (12 for class)

Thread = Orange

Head = Red glass bead

Tail = Burnt orange marabou or antron yarn w/ two strands copper angel hair or crystal flash

Body = Burnt orange sparkle chenille

Hackle = Grizzley dyed orange
