Directions:

- 1. Start thread on hook and apply dubbing to back 1/3 of hook, creating a large ball.
- 2. Tie on underwing.
- 3. Dub slim middle section.
- 4. Select clump of deer hair, clean and stack.
- 5. Dub front section.
- 6. Add a set of legs on each side.
- 7. Whip finish and trim thread.

Other color combinations – black/red/black, black/purple/black, and brown/tan/brown

Daiichi 1190, TMC 100 or 101 #12 – 16 8/0 Uni-Thread, color to match body 3 distinct segments – cinnamon, brown, cinnamon Holographic flat mylar Deer hair Black/white Turantu-Leggs, small or medium or Centipede Legs, White – Small
