Jack Gartside tied these for us at Blue Ribbon Fly Shop years ago and since it has become a go-to fly in our streamer boxes. It can work equally well when stripped like a streamer or swung like a soft hackle. You can't go wrong with this standout.

- 1) Hook: Dai-Riki 700 Size #4-#6
- 2) Thread: 3/0 red, white, yellow or Black (color to contrast marabou) cover hook shank with thread body.
- 3) Tail: two silver strands of Flashabou – Add ½ way up hook shank
- 4) Wing: Marabou wound as hackle. Tie in at tip and wind forward.  
Colors: Black, Olive, yellow, white, black/olive
- 5) Collar: Mallard Flank dyed to match marabou. Tie in at tip and wind forward.
