Materials

Hook: Dai Riki 075 or TMC 3769, #18 – 20

Thread: 8/0 black **Bead:** 1.5 mm silver

Tail: Brown Hungarian Partridge

Rib: Fine silver wire **Body:** Working thread

Wingcase: Mirage tinsel – small, pearl, black, red, copper

Thorax: Black midge Zelon dubbing

Directions

- 1. Smash hook barb and slide bead onto hook.
- 2. Attach thread and cover hook shank ending at barb.
- 3. Select about 5 fibers for tail and tie in at barb.
- 4. Tie in rib material at barb as well.
- 5. Wind thread forward to thorax area using smooth wraps, keeping body slim.
- 6. Wind rib forward to thorax using 4-6 wraps and tie off. Trim wire.
- 7. Tie in wingcase behind bead and take several wraps towards tail.
- 8. Apply dubbing and create thick thorax.
- 9. Pull wingcase over thorax and tie off.
- 10. Whip finish.
- 11. Pick out a few thorax fibers to create legs.

Variations: Tie different versions by changing the wingcase and use pearl, black, red, copper, mirage colors.
