

# Mrs. Simpson

**Hook:** Heavy wire hook #10 - #2

**Thread:** Black

**Tail:** Black squirrel or Brown Buck Tail

**Rear body:** Yellow, green or red chenille

**Middle body wing feathers:** Two pheasant 'semi-church' feathers (see instructions)

**Front body:** Yellow, green or red chenille

**Front feathers:** Four pheasant 'semi-church' feathers (see instructions)

- 1) **Starting** two eye lengths back from the eye make a thread base to hook bend.
- 2) **Add Tail - Length of hook shank.**



- 3) **Select 2 Feathers** from the lower body cape pheasant skin cape. Tie them in.
- 4) **Add Chenille** bind down firmly, wind  $\frac{1}{2}$  way up shank.
- 5) **Add Middle Body Wing Feathers** 2<sup>nd</sup> pair and **Front body chenille**



- 6) Mounting the Four Front Wing of the hook. (Facing you). See Picture for correct position.



- 7) **Carefully** fold the far pair of feathers over (like closing a book)  
Note how each set of body wing feathers overlap the previous pair by a half.
