HOOK: Dai Riki 135, size

10-14

THREAD: Olive or brown

RIBBING: 4X monofilament

SHELLBACK: Clear

Body Stretch

BODY: Bright green Haretron or sparkle dubbing or Quick Descent

LEGS: Starling, Partridge

or Equivalent

HEAD: Reddish brown Haretron or sparkle dubbing or Quick Descent



Uses

Imitates a drifting green caddis larva (green rockworm; genus Rhyacophila). For more on this pattern, see <u>Caddis Larvae--Part II.</u>

How to Fish

Use <u>tight line</u> or <u>trout indicator</u> nymphing tactics

Tying Instructions

1. Debarb hook, place in vise, start thread
2. Tie in shellback and mono ribbing.
3. Dub body; keep the body thin
4. Pull shellback over top, rib with monofilament.
5. Tie in starling (or leg hackle). Make one wrap and trim top and bottom fibers.
6. Dub head.
7. Whip finish and add small amount of head cement.
