
## 2 Whychus Canyon **Steelhead Fly** TMC 7989 Size 2 or Dai-Riki 899 #4 (Salmon/steelhead) Hook Thread Under Body Ultra Thread 70 - Black or UNI-Thread 6/0 Thread Head Ultra Thread 70 - Black or UNI-Thread 6/0 Tip/Tag Oval Silver Tinsel -fine, Lagartun Silk - Red or floss A Topping (Golden Pheasant Crest) Tail **Butt & Rib** Black Ostrich, Silver Tinsel - Fine Oval Body Silk - Light Green (LAND TRUST LOGO COLOR- Bright) (Body photo is tied in black) Hackle Pheasant Red Tipped Soft Feather Argus Pheasant (Optional Natural turkey) Wing

A Topping (Golden Pheasant Crest)


Step 1 – Make thread base & add oval tinsel tip

Step 2 – Add Red silk for tag

**Topping** 




Step 3 – Wrap Red silk to tensil tip and back to tie in point



Step 4 – Mount Phesant Tippet tail



Step 5 – Tie in ostrich hurl



Step 6 – Wrap Ostrich forward 5 turns



Step 7 – Tie in silk for body behind hook eye and wrap back to ostrich and forward to hook eye to form the body.



Step 8 – Wrap oval tensil forward, 6 wraps



Step 9 – Add Phesant collar



Step 10 – Add turkey wing (Optional Augus)



Step 11 – Add Phesant Crest topping



Step 12 - Whip finish and head cement.
